## **INSTRUCTIONS**

Section 1 – This is where you fill out who receives and where the analytical reports will be delivered to. In this section fill in company name, contact person, report delivery address, contact person's phone and fax numbers.

Section 2 – This is where you fill out who receives and where the invoice will be delivered to. If all information is the same as section 1, check the "Same as Reports" box in the upper right-hand corner of Section 2. If it is not the same, then fill out the company name, contact person, invoice delivery address, quote number, purchase order number, and project/job name or number. The project/job name or number and purchase order number will also be the one appearing on the reports.

Section 3 - This is where you fill in the e-mail address for both reporting and billing contacts.

Section 4 – This is where you fill out the type of analysis you want to have performed on the sample. If at all known, refer to specific methods and detection limits.


**Section 5** – This is where you determine the turnaround time of your sample. Place a check on the appropriate line from "normal" or "Rush" turnaround time options. If "Rush" is checked, please disclose the date to which you need your results on the "Needed By" line. Rushes need to be approved by the laboratory before acceptance.

Section 6 – This is where you fill out each sample's information. Use one line per sample container. In this section, fill in the date, time, matrix, container type, size and preservative.

Section 7 - This is where the person who took the sample signs and dates the Chain.

**Section 8** – This is where the person who delivers or picks up the sample signs and dates the Chain. Signatures, dates, and timestamps are necessary whenever the sample changes hands of ownership.

**Section 9** – This is where you may write down any comment or concerns you have pertaining to the sample, sample analysis, report or invoice delivery, turnaround time, etc.
